



**Annual Conference of the Canadian Association of Threat
Assessment Professionals (CATAP)

The 2017 CATAP Annual Conference will be held from October 25-27, 2017, at the Fairmont Le Manoir Richelieu.



We invite proposals for speakers and posters addressing topics in all areas of threat assessment and management; proposals that involve new and emerging topics within: general violence, domestic violence, stalking, work place, school violence, sexual assault, and terrorism. Proposals will be evaluated through a blind review process focused on intellectual merit, innovation, and integration of multiple aspects of the field.

The DEADLINE for submissions is Tuesday, February 28, 11:59pm PST

SPEAKERS: (sessions 60, 90 or 120 min): A presentation that would focus on one topic within threat assessment and management. Submissions should consist of a 200-300 word abstract.

POSTERS: Posters will be presented throughout the conference. Poster presentations are made in written format on display boards (size TBA). Submissions should consist of a 100-200 word abstract.

There will be a limit of TWO first-author speaker/poster submissions per person.
